| St. Andrews | Gill | Saturday 11 March is free. Could you let me know the starting and finishing times and whether you need rooms in addition to the hall? Do you need the kitchen? The hall is £17/hour and the kitchen is usually £10/hour, but for an all day meeting, I can usually make some reductions when I know precisely your requirements. |
| Broomhall Centre | Gill | Nothing come back |
| Abbeydale Picture House | Anna | Now out of the running. |
| Polish Club (Millenium Hall) | Kate | Available on both March 4th and 11th. To have the hall from 2pm till 11pm would cost £200, and it would be the same if we had it from 5 or any other time after 2. The woman I spoke to has pencilled me on for these two dates and I said I'd get back to her on Thursday to confirm whether we want either of them. Sounds like a pretty reasonable deal to me The only disadvantage of this venue is parking, but for public transport it's great and there is plenty of parking on side roads as long as people are aware of the meters and rules – too small now. |
| Merlin Theatre | Wendy | Friday 4 or Friday 11 March 2017 could be do-able. It would have to be from 4pm not 3pm, to allow our |

| | | students time to leave. We've got 2 performance spaces - the Arnold Freeman hall which seats up to 70, and the theatre which seats up to 200. Prices are £250 for Arnold Freeman hall, and £500 for the theatre. Both prices include use of the kitchen and cafe area and the cost of having a theatre manager on call at all times. Fine for you to bring and serve your own food. You'd have to finish and clear the building by 11pm. |

| St. Mary's | Wendy | St Mary's has availability on both dates in a room to accommodate 150. However, they do not allow for self catering. They are phoning me back with ball park figure including food. Less promising in the light of that. |
| Crookes Social Club | Wendy | Crookes Social Club has availability only on 4th March. Morris has pencilled us in on that date. 2 - 11pm. The concert room would be the space. Has capacity for up to 500 with a stage and also dance floor. No problem to do our own catering. However, they would want us to use their bar: fully licensed. Teas and coffees also available. That is how they make their profit. Hire cost £150. He is holding it for us. Does anyone know the space? We can go and view. I go on holiday this Wednesday for a week so someone else would need to do that. One of us probably knows the space anyway?. Let me know your thoughts. |
| Ecclesall Parish Hall | Carol | I've had a Google at Ecclesall Parish Hall. It's near Ecclesall library and on the bus route going up Eccy Road, about 10 minutes further by bus than where we used to sing. It's a good size, there is a stage, not too high, a kitchen and it holds 180 (see http://www.allsaintsecclesall.org.uk/page.php?page=66), but it's pricey at £340 for the hall and kitchen for the 2pm-11pm time span (£240 for the first 4 hours and £20 per hour thereafter). I haven't checked availability because of this, but could do if we think it's one for the list. |
